General Information:

Days & Hours: Monday through Friday, 9:00 am - 4:00 pm. We allow early drop off from 8:00 am and late pick-up after 4:00 pm. Please make arrangements with the office at the time of registration.

Transportation: We do not provide transportation to or from the summer riding program. Children will be released to a non-family member only with written permission and verbal confirmation at time of pick-up from a parent or known guardian.

Lunch: Participants must bring a complete lunch and a snack. Cold bottled water and fresh drinking water from our water fountain is available at all times. Any additional beverages should be included with packed lunch supplied by parents. We do not have vending machines!

Equipment: A certified horseback riding helmet (must have ASTM/SEI approved sticker) manufactured after the year 2000 is required. Helmets are available at MREC at no charge. Other safety requirements include long pants and a flat soled boot with a 1/2" shelf heel. Please send your child with a change of clothes for the afternoon, including sneakers and clothes that may get dirty during barn and other recreational activities. For safety reasons! **ABSOLUTLY NO RIDING WILL BE ALLOWED IN SNEAKERS OR SHORTS!**

Tuition: \$425 PER WEEK

Terms: To reserve your place, please send a registration fee of \$100 for each week of the riding program that is being attended - by cash or check (payable to Turner Equestrian) or via credit card in person or by phone, and complete our Summer **Riding Program Participation Agreement and Waiver**. The final balance is due on or before the first day of the Summer Riding Program.

Discounts: Sibling discounts are offered at the rate of 5% for the first sibling and each thereafter. Multiple week discounts are built into the tuition chart. A \$25 discount will be given to all Marlboro Ridge residence. One discount per household shall apply.

Health Requirements: Maryland Law requires that Participants not residing in the USA complete a Form 896, which is available online or by contacting our office.

This will include a mounted phase and an unmounted phase. Afterward, you are invited to hang around for refreshments (cookies and punch) while the kids prepare to leave.

Horsemanship and Horse-keeping: Horsemanship and horse-keeping are hands-on learning opportunities covering topics such as equine behavior, equipment, and veterinary care, grooming and feeding and anatomy.

Arts And Crafts: Creative time in the afternoon offers students a cool down break on warm summer afternoons in our air-conditioned classroom. Students will participate in a variety of fun games, painting, and construction projects.
